OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Deputation of Central Government servants on foreign service with U.N. Bodies-participation in the U.N. Pension Fund Scheme.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.1(16)-EIII(B)/66 dated the 5th November, 1966 on the subject cited above. In accordance with the orders contained in the afore-said Office Memorandum, officers of All India Services and Central Services deputed on foreign service to International Organisations like the U.N. Secretariat F.A.O/I.L.O. etc., are eligible to join the U.N. Joint Staff Pension Fund only as Associate participants where the period of foreign service is one year or more but less than five years subject to the conditions specified in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.1(47)-E.IV(A)/60 dated 18.10.60. They are allowed to join the U.N. Joint Staff Pension Fund as full members only where the assignment on foreign service is for a period of 5 years or more.

2. It has now been brought to the notice of Government that with effect from 1st January, 1967, the provision relating to Associate Participation in the U.N. Pension Fund has been abolished and in accordance with the revised rules, all staff members appointed on or after 1st January, 1967 for one year or more are required to join the U.N. Joint Staff Pension Fund as full members. The President is, therefore, pleased to decide that officers of the Central Services deputed to foreign service with International Organisations like the U.N. Secretariat F.A.O, I.L.O., etc., on a tenure of one year or more shall be allowed to join the U.N. Joint Staff Pension Fund as full members. The payment of retirement benefits accruing under the revised U.N. Pension Fund rules will, of course, continue to be regulated by the same conditions as laid down in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.1(16)-E.III(B)/66 dated 5.11.66.

3. Consequent upon the abolition of the Associate Participation in the U.N. Pension Fund the orders contained in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.1(47)-E.IV(A)/60 dated 18.10.60 will also cease to be operative.
