Subject: Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc.-Deputation (Duty) Allowance.

According to para 1(v) of this Ministry's 0.M. No. F.10(24)-E.III/60 dated the 4th May, 1961, an employee placed on deputation has the option to draw either the pay in the scale of pay of the new post as may be fixed under the normal rules or his basic pay in the parent Department plus deputation (duty) allowance. The option once exercised is final except that on each occasion when such an employee receives proforma promotion in his parent Department under the Next Below Rule or is reverted to a lower grade in the parent Department or is appointed to another grade in the new Department, a fresh option is allowed to him.

- The question of allowing Government servants on deputation a fresh option consequent on revision of the scale of the deputation post or that of the post held by a deputationist in his parent Cadre has been under consideration of the the Government. The President is now pleased to decide that when the scale of the deputation post or that of the post held by a deputationist in his parent cadre is revised with retrospective effect or from a prospective date Government servants on deputation may be allowed to exercise a fresh option. The benefit of the revised pay scale will, however, be subject to the restrictions laid down in this Ministry's 0.M. No.F.10(24)/E.III/60 dated 9.3.64.
- 3. These orders will have effect from the date of their issue and past cases already decided otherwise will not be re-opened.
- 4. In so far as the employees of the Indian Audit & Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
