Subject: - CENTRAL CIVIL SERVICES (REVISED PAY) RULES, 1960 - EXERCISE OF OPTION BY PRE - 1931 ENTRANTS.

The undersigned is directed to say that under clause (a) of Rule 8 of the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960, the option to elect the revised scale is admissible to a pre-1931 entrant only if the prescribed scales of all the posts held by the Government servant in an officiating as well as substantive capacity have undergone a revision under those rules. A question has been raised whether the expression 'all the posts held' used in that clause refers to the posts held or which would have been held by the Government servant concerned on Ist July, 1959 or to the posts held or which would have been held by the Government servant on or before Ist July, 1959. The undersigned is directed to clarify that the expression in question is intended to man the posts held or which would have been held but for his appointment to another post etc., on Ist July, 1959 only and not also to posts held or which would have been held prior to that date. Thus an Under Secretary to the Government of India who was drawing pay in the pre - 1931 scale can opt for the revised scales even P.T.O...)

though he had officiated as Deputy Secretary earlier than Ist July, 1959 but he cannot do so if he was holding the post of a Deputy Secretary on Ist July, 1959, whether in a long or short term vacancy.
