OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc. - Deputation (duty) allowance.

According to para 3 of this Ministry's O.M.No. F.10(24)-IIII/60 dated the 4th May,1961, where the minimum of the scale of pay of the deputation post is substantially in excess of the deputationist's basic pay plus deputation (duty) allowance at 20%, the appointing authorities are expected to apply the provisions of Fundamental Rule 35 and restrict the pay of the deputationist to a suitable figure below the minimum pay of the post.

- 2. There has been some lack of uniformity in the application of F.R.35 in such cases, resulting in anomalies. In order that a uniform practice is followed, it has been decided that the pay allowed under F.R.35 should not exceed the basic pay of the deputationist by more than the amounts shown below:
 - a) for employees in receipt of basic pay above Rs.750/-

25% of basic pay or Rs.225/- which-ever is more.

b) for employees in receipt of basic pay above Rs.300/- upto Rs.750/-.

30% of basic pay or Rs. 100/- which-ever is more.

c) for employees in receipt of basic pay of and below Rs.300/-.

33.1/3% of basic pay.

3. These orders will apply to cases of deputation commencing hereafter. In the case of employees already on deputation on the date of issue of this Office Memorandum, these orders will apply from the date of commencement of further extension, if any, of the period of deputation.

4. In so far as the employees of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
