Office Memorandum

Subject:- Deputation of Central Government Employees to top posts in public undertakings.

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The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to the Ministry of Finance Office Memorandum No. F.1(4)-E.III(B)/65, dated 10.3.1966 relating to the fixation of pay of Central Government Employees on deputation to 'top posts' in Public Sector Undertakings. These orders inter alia provide that provision of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.10(24)-E.III(B)/60, dated 4.5.1961 would not be applicable to deputationists appointed to hold 'top posts' i.e., posts classified in Schedule A, B, C and D in the Cabinet Secretariat Office Memorandum No. 72/45/71-IF-65, dated 13.10.1965. In other words, they would not be entitled to deputation allowance in terms of this Ministry's Office Memorandum dated 4.5.1961 but will have their pay fixed in accordance with the provisions of the Office Memorandum dated 10.3.1966.

2. It has come to notice that there are some posts in Public Sector Undertakings which though not classified as 'top posts' carry scales identical to those applicable to 'top posts'.

3. It is, therefore, clarified that even in respect of these posts, the orders of this Ministry's Office Memorandum dated 10.3.1966 are applicable and that no deputation allowance would be admissible to the Government employees appointed to hold posts carrying scales identical to those of 'top posts'. Past cases decided otherwise will not, however, be re-opened. Even in respect of cases where deputation allowance has been allowed to deputationists under public sector undertakings, it has been decided that the officers may continue to get deputation allowance for a maximum period of 3 years. If any extension in the period of deputation is granted beyond three years in the public interest, the extension would be without deputation allowance.

4. In so far as the staff of the Audit Department is concerned, the orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
