OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Fixation of pay of re-employed pensioners - General policy the reof.

In this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.7(38)-Est.III/62 dated the 18th October, 1962 it was decided that an increment falling due during the period of refused leave should not be taken into account for determining the pre-retirement pay of an officer in fixing his pay on re-employment and item (3) of the statement annexed to the Office Memorandum No.8(32)-Est.III/60 dated the 2ist July 1960 was cancelled. This item however applied to L.P.R. in general which would have included both ordinary leave preparatory to retirement and leave refused under F.R. 86. The difficulty in certifying that but for the leave the officer would have continued in the officiating post concerned exists in the case of refused leave only. In the case of ordinary leave preparatory to retirement it should

be possible to decide on the issue of such certificates on the merits of each case. It is accordingly clarified that item (3) of the statement annexed to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.8(32)-E.III/60 dated the 27th July 1960 should be deemed not to have been cancelled at all but that its provisions would not apply to increments falling due during "refused" leave.
