## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations etc. - Deputation (Duty) Allowance.

The undersigned isidirected to invite a reference to paragraph 1(iii) of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F:10(24)-E:III/60 dated the 4th May, 1961 and to say that the President has been pleased to decide in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India that I.A.& A.S. Officers holding posts of Assistant Comptroller and Auditor General, D.A.G.(Admn.), D.A.G.(O.A.D.) etc., who are in receipt of special pays in the Audit Department may be allowed to draw the special pay while on deputation subject to the Comptroller and Auditor General certifying that but for deputation they would have continued to draw it in the parent Department. The rate of deputation(duty) allowance admissible to them will, however, be 15% of the basic pay only (instead of 20% as provided under para 1(ii) of the Office Memorandum), subject to the condition

that the amount of special pay admissible in the I.A. & A.D. plus the amount of Deputation(Duty) Allowance does not exceed Rs.300/- p.m. The other conditions of the Office Memorandum referred to above will apply mutatis mutandis to them.

2. These orders will have effect from 4th May, 1961.
