It has also been decided that for the purpose of firstion of pay of re-employed military pensioners of J.C.O. rank and below who retired before 1.7.39 and are re-employed after 1.7.59, the pre-retirement pay should be taken as employed ments mentioned in the preceding paragraph plus two-thirds of the dearness allowance (including dearness pay and interim relief, if any) admissible to them at the rates in force on the civil side on the 30th June, 1959.
