
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc., Deputation (duty) allowance.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.10(24)-E.III/60 dated the 15th June, 1961 in accordance with which officers of I.A.&A.S. who are in receipt of special pay in the Audit Department are allowed deputation allowance at the rate of 15% of their basic pay in addition to special pay subject to the condition that the amount of special pay admissible in the I.A.&A.D. plus the amount of deputation (duty) allowance does not exceed Rs.300/-P.M. According to the orders contained in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. even dated 27.1.70, in the case of deputation within the same station, deputation (duty) allowance is admissible at the rate of 10% only. The President has, therefore, been pleased to decide in consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India that officers of I.A.&A.S. who are in receipt of special pay in the Audit Department on their appointment on deputation to ex-cadre posts "in the same station" may be allowed deputation (duty) allowance at 7½% of their basic pay in addition to special pay admissible to them in the parent Department subject to the condition that the amount of special pay admissible in the I.A.&A.D. plus the amount of deputation (duty) allowance does not exceed Rs. 300/- P.M. This is subject to the Comptroller and Auditor General certifying that but for deputation they would have continued to draw the special pay in the parent Department. The other conditions of the Office Memorandum dated 27.1.70 referred to above will apply mutatis mutandis to them.

2. These orders will take effect from the date of their issue. Persons who are on deputation on the date of issue of these orders and are in receipt of Deputation(duty) allowance at 15% of their basis pay under the orders dated 15.6.61 will continue to draw Deputation (duty) allowance at the same rate so long as they hold the same post.
