OFFICE MEMORANDUM


Subject: - Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc. Deputation (duty) allowance.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that according to para 1(v) of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.10 (24)-E.III/60 dated 4.5.61, an employee placed on deputation can elect to draw either the pay in the scale of pay of the deputation post as may be fixed under the normal rules or his basic pay in the parent department plus deputation (duty) allowance. It is also provided that for determining the pay under the normal rules for this purpose in case of deputation to autonomous bodies, it may be assumed that the Government rules apply.

2. In this connection, a doubt has been raised whether in the case of deputation of Government employees on foreign service to Public Sector Undertakings which follow their own rules for fixation of pay, the pay of a deputationist Government employee will be regulated under the provisions of F.Rs. or in accordance with the rules followed by the Public Sector Undertaking. It is hereby clarified that even in the case of deputation of Government employees on foreign service to Public Sector Undertakings, if a Government servant opts for pay in the pay scale of the deputation post, that pay will be regulated under the provisions of F.Rs or in terms of the provisions of this Ministry's Office Memorandum of even No. dated 9.3.64, as the case may be.

3. In so far as the employees of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
