## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

UNDER THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE THIRD PAY OF MMISSION.

The wersigned is directed to say that cases have come to notice which a senior Government servant promoted to higher post being 1.1.73 draws less pay in the revised scales becommended by the Pay Commission than his junior who is promoted to the higher post after that cruicial date.

In orderto remove the above anomaly, the President is lease to decide hat in such cases, the pay of the senior officer in the revised sle in the higher post should be stepped up to figure equal the pay as fixed for the junior officer in that it is post promod on or after 1.1.73. The stepping up should and with effit from the date of promotion of the junior officer should be seet to the following conditions:

- (a) Both tijunior and senior officer should belong to the same cre and the posts in which they have have been promot should be identical in the same cadre.
- (b) The univised and rewised scales of pay of the lower and hier posts in which they are entitled to draw pay should identical; and
- The amly should be directly as a resit of the polication of throvisions of FR 22 C in the revsed scale. For eple, if even in the lower post, the junior officer was ding more pay in the un revised scale than the senior virtue of fixation of pay under the normal rules or andvance incrments granted to him, the provisions contad in this decision need not be invoked to step up the pof the senior officer.

Theders fe-fixing the pay of the senior officer accordance h the provisions of this decision should be under 17 and the next incrment of the desenior officer with be drawn completion of the required qualifying service with error from tlate of refixation of pay.

Thorders take effect from the date of issue. Cases described drawingspay in the revised scale than the junior in respect of priom, occurring on or after 1.1.73 may also be regulated unchese orders, but the actual benefit would be reallable free date of the issue of these orders.
